The Groups Administrator role does not have access to advanced hunting or Microsoft Defender ATP.

This add-on includes Microsoft Defender ATP and allows you to use advanced hunting features<sup>3</sup>. Alternatively, you can request one of the roles that have access to advanced hunting, such as Security administrator or Global administrator.
